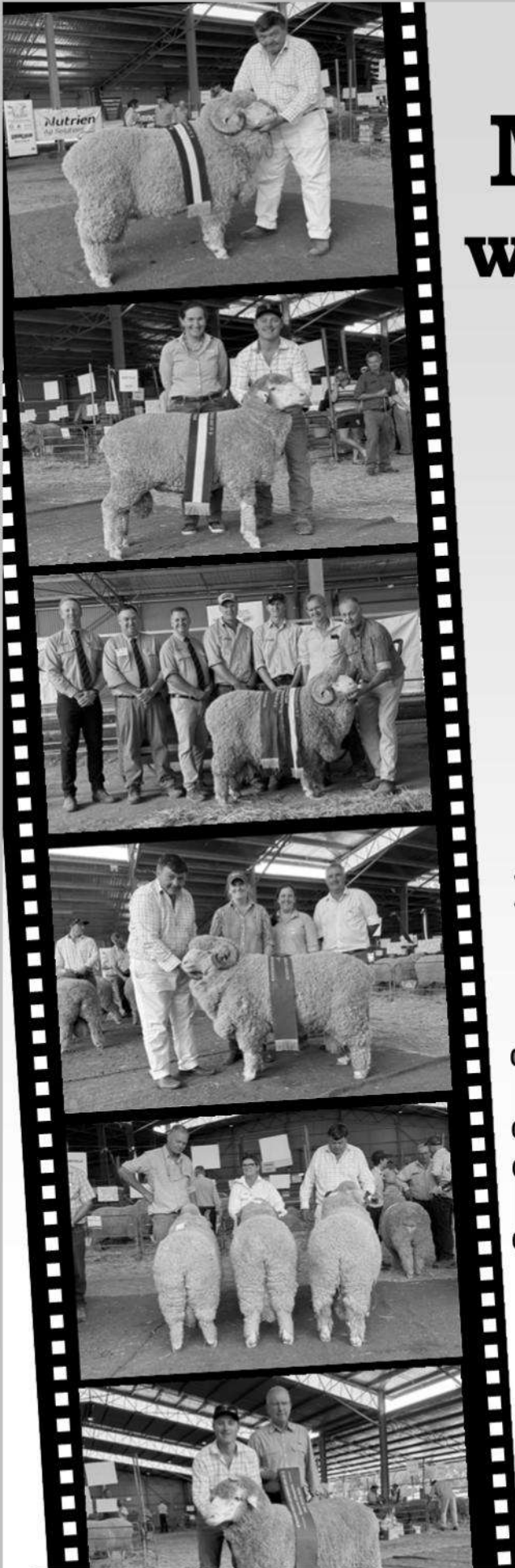

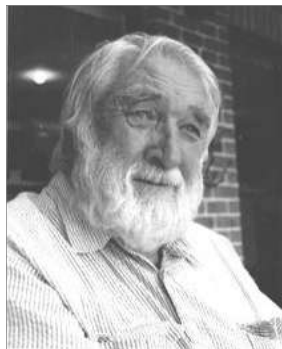

GUIDELINES FOR SAMPLE COLLECTION OF RAMS

1. Samples are taken in November and sent to AWTA.
2. August shorn to be tested in January at AWTA.
3. The sample taken, should only be the size of a cigarette packet or size of a narrow comb. Sample must be as close as possible to the skin.
4. Samples should be taken on the left side, when standing facing the ram's head.
5. The sample should be located from the area designated as the mid-side location.
6. If the ram has already been sampled on that side, take another sample as close as possible to the first sample. (Do not include any shorter wool from the first sample).

GUIDANCE FOR NVD COMPLETION

Please transfer all sale rams to the Armidale Exhibition Centre PIC Number **NI 024703** on your NVD.

Remember that each ram to be offered for sale, must have an original NVD, **no photo copy will be accepted.**

GUIDANCE FOR WOOL CLASSIFICATION.

7.30 a.m. Wednesday morning the 4th February all rams that vendors intend to show will be classified by the nominated judges.

The chief steward will be present to take entries for the show during classification. Vendors should be available between 8.30 a.m. and 11.30 a.m. for this to make entries and hold nominated sheep for classification.

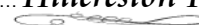

Show and Sale Conditions of Entry

1. No age restriction in any class. Entries will be taken on the day (Wednesday 4th February between 7.30am and 8.00pm after classification).
2. All sheep should be healthy, Brucellosis accredited and Footrot free. Rams and display sheep must be free of external parasites, if detected all sheep from that stud will be immediately removed. A health statement must accompany all entries.
3. Show entries are confined to Sale Rams only.
4. All rams must bear a state Sheepbreeders' regulation shearing inspection tag (March or August 2025).
5. The judge's decision is final and no disputes will be entered into. Any subject not covered by the conditions will be decided by the NMRBA Incorp. committee.
6. The NMRBA Incorp. committee will not be held responsible for any loss, damage or injury whatsoever incurred or caused by exhibits, exhibitors or property.
7. All show sheep to wear compulsory micron tickets (on poll) for judging (AWTA micron to be displayed).
9. All Show Classes must adhere to visual appraisal of 80's / 74's / 70 / 64 counts. Ultrafine classes must be 17.5 mic and finer (AWTA Test).
10. **The Vendors, Agents, Committee and associated companies will not be held responsible for any disputes that may arise in relation to test results of micron measurements.**
11. 1% commission to outside agents, notifying 24 hours prior to Sale.
12. **August Shorn rams will be judged separately. Open to both horned and poll rams. March shorn (horn and poll to be one class).**
13. The NMRBA Incorporated rely totally on the information supplied by the vendor. Purchasers should check details with the vendor.
14. Stud averages for the sale are calculated on the rams offered for sale on the close of agent books on sale day on three year rolling average.
15. All nominated show sheep to be classified by Judges.
16. Microns on display must be from samples taken.
17. Pen of two (2) rams must be from the same registered stud number. To be judged under uniformity of wool and type. Must be from the same shearing.
18. Scurs should not exceed 25mm for Poll rams.
19. August shorn rams to be penned and sold in same run of rams from each vendor. March shorn rams will be lotted first.
20. A ram that is under a sale contract is not eligible for exhibition or sale.

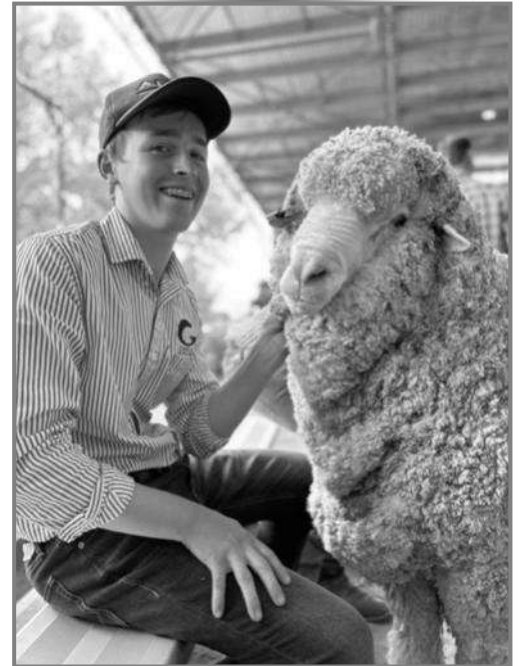

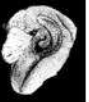

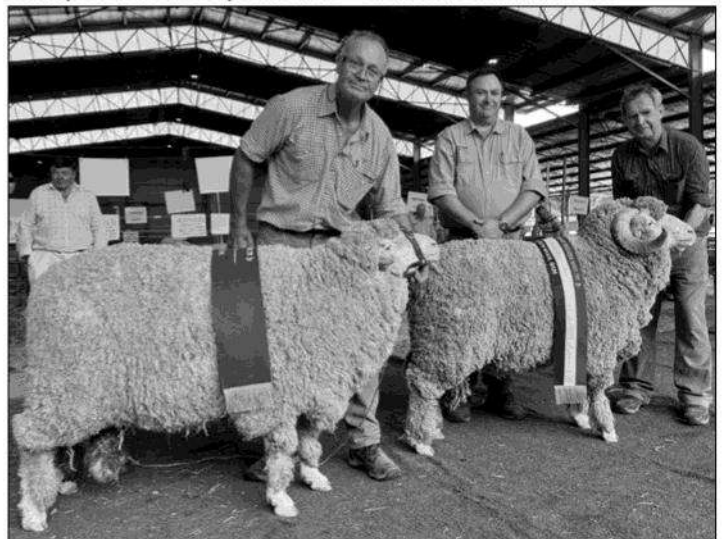

Rams can be put on a finishing ration four to six weeks prior to the sale to add extra bodyweight and finish to your sale rams.

Peter encourages communication during the time your stud sheep are on Fabstock to make sure things are ticking along nicely and to stop any potential problems early should they arise.

For the stud breeder who mixes his own feed Fabstock can supply you with a complete vitamin/Mineral concentrate designed to produce maximum results from your mix. Special Ingredients you may not have access to such as linseed meal can be added to the mix on your request.
